
Pay attention to the collection days, which are different for each area

- Area A: commercial area, former Burgo district, Lavagna district
- Area B: historic centre, Giardino district
- Area C: Giorgella district, Sant'Adele district



What's changed?

- The collection days for paper and cardboard will change: on Thursdays in Area A, Fridays in Area B, Saturdays in Area C;
- Plastic and metal will be collected twice a week: Mondays and Thursdays in Area A, Tuesdays and Fridays in Area B, Wednesdays and Saturdays in Area C;
- 3. **Unsorted waste will be collected once a week**: Mondays in Area A, Tuesdays in Area B, Wednesdays in Area C.

The calendars for the areas of separate waste collection in Corsico have undergone no changes.

In addition to door-to-door separate collection, it is possible to:

- book the free service for bulky waste at www.amsa.it;
- bring cumbersome, bulky waste, WEEE and inert waste to the municipal ecological platform in the allowed quantities and limits.
- use the Mobile Environmental Centre provided on a monthly basis in the various districts of the city.

Organic

Twice a week collection **Area A:** Mondays, Thursdays Area B: Tuesdays, Fridays **Area C:** Wednesdays, Saturdays



Paper and cardboard

Weekly collection **Area A:** Thursdays Area B: Fridays Area C: Saturdays



Dirty oiled and sandpaper, till receipts, broken dishes, glasses, ceramic cups, non-electronic plastic toys and without batteries, CDs, DVDs, audio cassettes and videotapes, filters and bags for vacuum cleaners, cigarette butts, nappies, sanitary pads, plasters, disposable razors



Medicines, containers of toxic products, batteries, eneray-savina light bulbs.



Kitchen scraps, food leftovers by removing excess liquids, household meat and fish scraps (also bones, bone fragments and feathers), egg shells, fruit and vegetable scraps (also woody parts, dried fruit and pits), rice, pasta, bread, biscuits and flour, coffee grounds, tea filters and other infusion drinks, used paper towels, cut flowers, plant cuttings and leaves in small quantities.



Nappies and sanitary pads, paper for food packaging. dog droppings, garden mowing and prunings.



Newspapers, notebooks and magazines (without adhesive, metal and plastic parts), paper bags, cardboard trays and boxes for food, cardboard packaging for toys and clothing, pizza boxes without food residue, beverage cartons.



Pizza boxes with food residues, baking paper, till receipts, plastic bags.



Plastic and metal

Glass

Weekly collection Area A: Mondays **Area B:** Tuesdays **Area C:** Wednesdays



Cuttings and prunings

Weekly collection Area A: Thursdays **Area B:** Fridays **Area C:** Saturdays



Plastic bottles, beverage cans, plastic plates and cups, plastic bags and film (including cellophane). bottles and tubes, trays, tins and containers for food (also in polystyrene and plastic), plastic wrap for packing, including bubble wrap, caps and lids, metal coffee pots, chains, and small metal objects.



Pens, containers of toxic products, toothbrushes, disposable razors.



Glass bottles and jars. Rinse the container and remove the lid.



Ceramics, containers in Pirex and crystal, mirrors, light bulbs.



Grass clippings, cut flowers, branches, hedge prunings, plant residues from garden weeding. Packages in tied bundles, with a maximum length of 1 metre, a maximum weight of 10 kg and a maximum volume of 100 litres, with a maximum of 5 pieces. Only biodegradable materials can be used for these bundles.



Stones and earth, nylon, plastic and terracotta pots, metals, bags and cellophane.

Hours of placement outside: Waste must be placed at the roadside no earlier than 10 p.m. on the day before collection and no later than 6 a.m. on the day of collection.
